Dear Allen County Regional Water and Sewer District Customer,

In June, the Board of Trustees of the Allen County Regional Water and Sewer District (the "District") entered into a Letter of Intent ("LOI") with Fort Wayne City Utilities for Fort Wayne City Utilities ("City Utilities") to assume the assets, debt, and operations of the District.

The Letter of Intent allows the District and City Utilities to continue negotiations and seek financing assistance from the Indiana State Revolving Fund to facilitate the transaction.

If the agreement becomes final, the transaction could close by the end of the year, and City Utilities would serve customers around January 1, 2022.

City Utilities has already been providing many operational and billing procedures for the District. If approved, the change would mean current District customers would see a rate reduction to what other City Utilities' customers pay. Most District customers would see a savings of approximately forty dollars per month.
